**Reminder Letter**

You are receiving this Reminder Letter because you are a holder of DG licence granted under the Dangerous Goods (General) Regulation, Cap 295B and we have not yet received your application for new DG licence under the amended Dangerous Goods Ordinance.


You are no doubt aware that the amended Dangerous Goods Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation had come into effect on 31 March 2022. After the 24-month transitional period expiring on 30 March 2024, your DG licence(s) granted previously will become invalid. In such cases, you may no longer be permitted to use the premises for DG related purposes and will be demanded to remove all DG and associated installations from that premises. Pursuant to the Dangerous Goods Ordinance, anyone who manufactures, stores, conveys or uses DG without the required DG licence shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine at Level 6 and to imprisonment for 6 months.

If you intend to continue using your premises for DG related purposes, you shall ensure that the premises on or before 30 March 2024 fulfil the requirements stipulated in the new legislation and be issued with new licence(s) granted by this Department. All applications for DG licence should be submitted at least 3 months in advance to allow sufficient time for processing.

You may still renew your existing DG licence(s) under the Dangerous Goods (General) Regulation, Cap 295B during the transitional period. For the purpose of facilitating you to comply with the new regulation and for effective case management, the licence renewal period may be shortened to cater for different circumstances.

Your case will be handled by a designated Case Officer who would provide one-stop services to guide you through the application process.
